



Let's go to Sapporo

sapporo

Ezo, where the Ainu people lived, was renamed Hokkaido in 1869. A pioneer was placed and the construction of Sapporo Honbu began. Based on the far-reaching Sapporo construction plan, people laid railroads, started industry, and built the capital city of Sapporo. Since the enforcement of the city system in 1922, the city area and population have been expanded through repeated mergers and incorporations with neighboring towns and villages.



Sapporo Snow Festival



The origin of the Snow Festival is that in 1950, junior and senior high school students in Sapporo installed six snow sculptures in Odori Park. Originally, Odori Park was a place where citizens came to throw away snow that had been shoveled. It started with making a snow sculpture using the snow. It wasn't until 1953 that giant snow sculptures began to be made. The 15-meter-high heavy snow statue "Ascension" was created by Hokkaido Sapporo Fushimi High School. Until then, the height was limited to 7 meters. In 1959, about 2500 people were mobilized to make snow sculptures. This situation was first introduced on TV and newspapers, and the number of tourists from all over Japan increased from the following year. It became an event that represents Japan and became famous in Japan.


A clock tower that tells the city of Sapporo with the sound of a bell every hour on the hour.

We offer simple soup curry that makes the best use of the taste of Hokkaido ingredients. Finished with only salt and spices.




A soft serve ice cream made from "White lover" chocolate and Hokkaido milks. It has a light and rich taste of milk, and is characterized by its light sweetness.



White lover is famous as a souvenir from Hokkaido, so please try it.




Jaga pokkuru, which has been popular in Hokkaido for long time, is a standard souvenir.






Three way six was born in 1965 and is a famous confection that has been loved by the people of Hokkaido. Please buy it if you like.

January Snow and Light Competition

Hakodate Illumination at Hachimanzaka

Cherry blossoms start blooming in Matsunae-cho, the southernmost part of Hakodate City. Cherry blossoms bloom every year around the beginning of Golden Week; and Goryokaku Park and Hakodate Park are crowded with people who enjoy cherry blossom viewing in historical spaces.

Fireworks display at Hakodate Port Festival, which colors the summer night sky.




The Hakodate Port Festival is held every year from August 1st to the 5th.


December Christmas fantasy at the beginning of winter

It is a museum where you can see very beautiful stained glass. You can borrow an audio and know the contents of the work and the back ground of the times.



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



• Otaru Unga

• Unga Park


A park built in the place that was once the ship entry of Nippon Yusen. There is a playset facility building and a rest building that reused the stone warehouse.

• Former National Railways Temiya Line

The former Temiya Line was opened in 1880 as the first line in Hokkaido connecting Temiya and Sapporo, and was active as a transportation line for goods. Even after the line is discontinued, the rails and railroad crossings are left as they are, and you can freely walk on the track.
