学習目標	<p>Aims of the language B (English B) course are to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. develop international-mindedness through the study of language, culture, and ideas and issues of global significance. 2. enable students to communicate in the language they have studied in a range of contexts and for a variety of purposes. 3. encourage, through the study of texts and through social interaction, an awareness and appreciation of a variety of perspectives of people from diverse culture. 4. develop students' understanding of the relationship between the languages and cultures with which they are familiar. 5. develop students' awareness of the importance of language in relation to other areas of knowledge. 6. provide students, through language learning and the process of inquiry, with opportunities for intellectual engagement and the development of critical- and creative- thinking skills. 7. provide students with a basis for further study, work and leisure through the use of an additional language. 8. foster curiosity, creativity and a lifelong enjoyment of language learning.
学習方法	<p>Students develop the ability to communicate in the target language (English) through the study of language, themes (identities, experiences, human ingenuity, social organisation and sharing the planet) and texts. In doing so, they also develop conceptual understandings of how language works. Communication is evidenced through receptive, productive and interactive skills across a range of contexts and purposes that are appropriate to the level of the course.</p>
